Family Heritage

Owned by the de Boüard de Laforest family since 1910, when Maurice de Boüard de Laforest inherited the estate. The family's roots in Saint-Émilion extend back to 1782, with each generation maintaining an unwavering commitment to excellence. Today, Stéphanie de Boüard-Rivoal represents the eighth generation at the helm of this iconic estate.

Premier Grand Cru Classé A

In 2012, Château Angélu achieved the pinnacle of recognition in Saint-Émilion's classification system, being elevated to Premier Grand Cru Classé A status. This prestigious designation placed it among the elite handful of estates at the very top of Saint-Émilion's hierarchy, recognizing decades of exceptional quality and terroir expression.

Exceptional Terroir

The vineyard spans 23.4 hectares on south-facing slopes near Saint-Émilion, creating a natural amphitheater. Planted predominantly with Merlot (50%) and Cabernet Franc (47%) with a touch of Cabernet Sauvignon (3%), the estate benefits from unique clay-limestone soils that impart distinctive minerality and complexity to the wines.
