Historic Legacy

Origins trace to the 13th century; Romanée-Conti acquired by the Prince de Conti in 1760.

19th century consolidation under Duvault-Bloch; estate centered in Vosne-Romanée, Côte de Nuits.

Grand Cru Monopole Classification

Romanée-Conti Grand Cru is a monopole of DRC (complete ownership of the vineyard).

La Tâche is also a Grand Cru monopole; additional holdings include Richebourg, Romanée-Saint-Vivant, Grands-Échezeaux, Échezeaux, and Montrachet (shared).

Biodynamic Excellence

Organic practices for decades; certified Biodyvin (biodynamic) since 2017.

Low-input, handwork, and meticulous selection express profound terroir purity.

Record-Breaking Prices

Among the world's most valuable wines; 1945 Romanée-Conti sold for £435,000 at Sotheby's (2018).

Extremely low yields; hand harvesting; whole-cluster use as vintage allows.

Target benchmark vintages across La Tâche, Richebourg, Romanée-Saint-Vivant, Grands-Échezeaux, and Échezeaux to build a comprehensive portfolio of DRC wines.

Study vintage arcs and terroir nuance while balancing acquisition cost against appreciation potential, focusing on critically acclaimed years that showcase the distinctive character of each vineyard.

Format Diversification

Incorporate standard 750ml bottles for portfolio liquidity and flexibility, while selectively adding magnums and jeroboams for superior aging curve and enhanced collectibility.

Large format bottles of DRC are produced in extremely limited quantities and are highly prized at auction, commanding significant premiums and offering unique investment differentiation.

Portfolio Optimization

Include Vosne-Romanée 1er Cru Cuvée Duvault-Bloch for earlier drinking pleasure while the Grand Cru wines develop their full complexity over decades.

Insist on impeccable provenance and professional storage conditions to preserve investment value, regularly reassessing holdings against market trends to maintain optimal portfolio balance.
